15 Forms of Government Issued ID

- 1. Driver's License: Issued by state DMVs for driving and identification purposes.
- 2. Passport: Internationally recognized travel document issued by governments.
- 3. **Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)**: For non-U.S. citizens who are permanent residents in the United States.
- 4. State ID Card: Non-driver identification issued by state DMVs.
- 5. **Employment Authorization Card**: Issued by USCIS to authorize employment for noncitizens.
- 6. Student ID: Issued by educational institutions to students for identification purposes.
- 7. Tribal ID: Issued by recognized Native American tribes.
- 8. Voter ID Card: Issued by states for voting purposes.

- 10. Government Employee ID: Issued to federal, state, or local government employees.
- 11. Consular ID Card: Issued by foreign consulates to their citizens living abroad.
- 12. Merchant Mariner Credential: Issued by the U.S. Coast Guard to mariners.
- 13. **Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC)**: Issued by TSA for workers in the transportation industry.
- 14. NEXUS Card: A border crossing card for travel between the U.S. and Canada.
- 15. Enhanced Driver's License (EDL): Includes proof of identity and U.S. citizenship for border crossings by land or sea.
- 16. **Medicare Card**: Issued by the U.S. government for Medicare beneficiaries (elderly and disabled individuals).
